Call to Order –

Approval of Minutes

The minutes from 11/13/2025 were voted on – all were in favor – Motion Carried.

Reports of Officers and Standing Committees

- **Legislative Task Force Committee:** Committee Chair, Bert Reeves, presents some of the new language he has been working on with the bylaws, rules and standing procedures. He explains that they could potentially be voted on today and the wording would still be flexible in the future. Bert explains the proposal of the 3 subgroups divided for each month to vote on their assigned case level. One Clinical Evaluator would be assigned per group. The Executive Director will assign the case level each month as it rotates. Bert explains that the law states that every Board Member shall vote, it does not state that each Board Member shall review each case so this will not be an issue adding the creation of subgroups. If a case is requested to be pulled it would then be sent to the Board Members from the Executive Director for each Board Member to review before the next meeting. There is more discussion on how many representatives would be required per subgroup to attend each meeting. The consensus is 1 representative per subgroup. Tracy states that something can be put in place, such as a document, that is signed each month by each Board Member affirming that they reviewed their assigned cases so that the subgroup representative is not responsible for any members possible absence. Jerry Bruce asks if SORRB falls under the Administrative Procedure Act, in which case the new rules and procedures would need to follow their protocol. AAG rep, Shanna-Kay Gibbs states she will research and see if SORRB will need to follow that. Bert asks everyone to please send any suggestions or edits before next month's Board Meeting and is hopeful that by next month, some of the changes will be ready for voting. Tracy also mentions that since the SORRB database has just migrated to GTA, there may be some avenues in the future to create markers in the database for the Board Members case review process to become easier.

Investigator Report

Chief Investigator, Russ Finley, states that 139 cases were closed last month. Tracy adds that the investigative team has been continuing to successfully identify high priority and one offense cases and continue to prep their cases excellently for the Clinical Evaluators which creates a seamless process all around for case review.

Clinical Evaluator Report

Director of Operations, Amanda Aten, shares that a full-time Clinical Evaluator, Shawn Henry, has just started with SORRB. She states another 2 full-time Clinical Evaluators and 1 part-time Clinical Evaluator are starting January 2nd which will place the Clinical Evaluator positions at capacity.
