Jim Morton states he did review the case again and agrees that the treatment provider implemented what was needed to discuss the offender's issues and agrees with lowering to a Level 1. Ezell Brown also agrees to reduce to Level 1 stating all requirements of the offender have been met. Mindy Ackerman also agrees with Level 1. Tracy explains to Board Members that during the Roll Call Vote they can state if there is a case they do not agree with.
