Approval of Minutes

Reports of Officers and Standing Committees

Tracy provides a brief explanation regarding the need for a new committee to meet and discuss options for the recent and upcoming increase of cases for the Board to read & vote on. She explains she spoke with a contact at the Governor's Office and SORRB will be able to work on legislation directly with them, making it a much quicker process to put a solution in place. Bert Reeves volunteers to lead this committee and states he will start researching options. This Legislative Task Force Committee will consist of the Board Chair, Frank Mullis, Board Vice Chair, Mindy Ackerman and Board Members, Bert Reeves, Robbie Frederick, Elizabeth Bigham and Jerry Bruce. Mindy states she will reach out to set up future meetings.

Executive Director's Report

Executive Director Tracy Alvord presented her report:

<u>Database:</u> Tracy explains the SORRB database was created in 2018 by a company, Invictus, who also
created the DCS database. This company was needed specifically to align with the needs of the
platform for SORRB. She states there were 2 recommendations for state contractors at the time and they

were not able to meets SORRBs needs for this project. Tracy states there is a meeting set up today with DBHDD procurement to discuss the encumbering of funds & purchase type needed for these necessary SORRB database updates with Invictus.

- <u>July 1, 2025 Hiring Goal</u>: Tracy explains 1 new Investigator has just been hired and anticipates 4 new full time Clinical Evaluator positions to be filled. The expectation was a July 1st start date but that will be pushed to August 1st. These 5 positions will max out all SORRB staff positions.
- <u>ATSA September 2025</u>: Tracy and Markus will be attending this conference in September.
- GATSA August 2025: Tracy explains that GATSA (Georgia Association for the Prevention and Treatment of Sexual Offenders) is hosting a 1-day virtual training with a well renowned team of presenters regarding CSEM & research. Tracy encourages all to attend. Board Members with confirmed attendance include Frank Mullis, Mindy Ackerman, Jim Morton & Elizabeth Bigham with Meghan Thurmond and Katie Gropper tentatively attending.
- <u>SOR Conference August 2025:</u> Deputy Director, Richard Hammond and Chief Investigator, Russ Finley will be attending the Sexual Offender Registry conference in August.
- <u>Topic Request for Education Series</u>: Tracy asks Board Members to please continue sending topics for training following Board Meetings conducted by SORRB Research and Legislative Analyst, Markus Wiegel. Tracy reminds Board Members to remain on after today's meeting for training. Today's topic is Sex Offenders and Aging. SORRB Clinical Evaluator staff will attend this as well.

Deputy Director's Report

Deputy Director Richard Hammond presented his report:

- New Office Update: Richard explains demolition started about 4 weeks ago and renovations are moving along swiftly. As of now, estimated project completion is slated for mid-late July. This is mostly dependent on HVAC component lead time and installation. SORRB's AV company is also scheduled for installation the second week of August. Richard states new furniture for the entire office has been ordered and delivery will hopefully line up with the project completion timeline. Board Chair, Frank Mullis asks if everything aligned with the budget and Tracy explains that with some communication with a contact at the Governor's Office everything was able to be handled efficiently.

Investigator Report

Chief Investigator, Russ Finley shares that the Investigators closed 185 cases last month. He states case completion numbers are growing and should continue to steadily increase as the new hires continue to gain more experience.

Clinical Evaluator Report

Clinical Evaluator Supervisor, Amanda Aten states Board Members will notice reports by a new Clinical Evaluator beginning in July and reports will continue to increase as each month goes by.

REEVALUATION CASES – 10 cases presented for vote

- Discussion: <u>23563</u>- Bert Reeves asks for clarification regarding the information of the offender completing treatment leading to the decrease in leveling. It is confirmed that if SORRB had this information for the original evaluation, the offender would have been originally classified as a Level 1. <u>27162</u>- Bert Reeves expresses concern with the lewd acts of this case involving a 33-year-old offender and a 3-year-old victim, the offender's daughter. Katie Gropper concurs and adds that the underlying fact pattern is a concern when looking at the case details and lack of time free in the community. Bert asks for clarification regarding the Sex Offender Treatment Intervention and Progress Scale (SOTIPS), Frank Mullis and Markus Wiegel both explain some details about the use of SOTIPS and how it was applied in this offender's treatment. There are also shared concerns over the offender's admission of excessive masturbation as well as having fantasies regarding his minor stepdaughter. Amanda Aten explains that the decrease in leveling is partially due to the offender's voluntary involvement in continued treatment as well as the offender recognizing he had a problem with excessive masturbation and reaching out to his officer and treatment provider. In conclusion, Board Members decide to vote on this case.

Since the vote to remain Level 2 is one short of a quorum, it is determined that case #27162 will be pulled for further review and will be voted on again in the next Board Meeting.

<u>3431-</u> Bert expresses concern with this 10-year re-evaluation. Although the offender has not committed a new known sex offense in 10 years, he has a history of non-compliance and was terminated from sex offender treatment. Jim Morton recommends further review of this case.
