Executive Director's Report

Executive Director Tracy Alvord presented her report:

- <u>Appropriations</u>: Tracy announced that Governor Kemp signed the budget for FY 2025 and SORRB will be receiving the funds to move forward with our goals.
- <u>SORRB Restructuring /FY 2025 Goals:</u> Tracy states the new budget will allow for promotion, which will help with staff retention. SORRB has never had the ability to promote in the last 18 years. She has emailed her ideas to Frank and Gerard. Tracy then plans to hire additional staff, which will include Investigators, Clinical Evaluators, and Administrative staff. Tracy explains that the critical hire positions for current vacancies have been approved by DBHDD and will be posted soon. Then she can begin interviewing applicants. Tracy hopes all available positions will be filled by July 1st. Tracy has also submitted requests for additional positions, but this includes more steps and is a longer process. There will be several part time & full time positions available for Clinical Evaluators and Investigators. Tracy explains all positions

go through DBHDD but will be available for the public to apply. However, any recommendations can be emailed to her. Tracy explains the training process for new hires will be at least 2 weeks long with the expectation of being trained adequately within 6 months. During that time, there will not be any significant changes to the monthly case load, however, the Board will need to start thinking about future processes with larger caseloads. Hopefully by the next fiscal year, the number of monthly cases will significantly increase and help eliminate backlog. Tracy will keep the Board updated monthly.

- <u>ICAC Conference</u>: Tracy will be attending the ICAC Conference (Internet Crimes Against Children) in June along with a few staff members. ICAC is a great national resource for updated information regarding internet crimes. Chief Investigator Russ Finley and Clinical Evaluator Kirsten Lawon will be hosting a SORRB booth to answer all SORRB related questions from various law enforcement agencies.
- <u>Investigators:</u> Chief Investigator Russell Finley has spoken with Tracy about Investigator Richard Hammond and the vast amount of progress he has made completing Dekalb County cases. Richard has done an excellent job collaborating with Dekalb County.
- <u>Future Training:</u> Tracy explains that she and SORRB's Research and Training Expert, Markus Wiegel are working on trainings for various State of Georgia agencies. In July, there will be training for treatment providers, polygraph examiners, and DCS. Tracy has spoken with both Board Members Robbie Frederick and Lori Rozier to collaborate on this training. Treatment providers and polygraph examiners will be educated on what SORRB needs and what they can be looking out for to assist with their clients. Board Chair, Frank Mullis will be in attendance to present about the Boards role with SORRB. There will hopefully be many future trainings. Lastly, Tracy states she will be attending the PAC conference this July with Board Member Katie Gropper.
